My Dear Brother,

السلام عليكم ورحمة الله وبركاته

I trust that by the Grace of Allah this letter finds you in the best of your health. I wish to draw your attention towards the oncoming quarterly Tarbiyyat week from 22nd to 29th January 2010. As you would be aware that during this week we strive to:

- Offer at least Fajr and Isha prayers in congregation at the mosque/Salat Centre where available.
- Make special efforts to offer daily Tahajjud Prayers during this week.
- Ensure daily recitation of Holy Qur'an and read translation with commentary.
- Make extra effort to ensure that all eligible family members also offer Prayers regularly and recite the Holy Quran daily.
- Write a letter to Hazrat Khalifatul Masih V *أيده الله تعالى بنصره العزيز* for prayers and encourage all family members including children to the same.
- Attend Friday prayers at the Mosque/Salat Centre.

Hazrat Khalifatul Masih V *أيده الله تعالى بنصره العزيز* has repeatedly reminded Ansar of their responsibility for Tarbiyyat of children and other family members. Regularity in Salat guarantees the spiritual future of our progeny and offering salat in congregation where ever possible is compulsory. Holy Quran says *إِنَّ الصَّلَاةَ تَنْهَىٰ عَنِ الْفَحْشَاءِ وَالْمُنْكَرِ* Surely, Prayer restrains *one* from indecency and manifest evil (29:46). Hazrat Abu Hurairah relates that the Holy Prophet said: The first item in respect of which a person would be called to account on the Day of Judgement will be Prayer. If that is found in order he would be successful and prosper, but if that is not in order he would be ruined and lost. (Tirmizi). The Promised Messiah says: So all ye people who count yourselves as members of my Jama'at, in heaven you shall be counted members of my following only when you truly begin to advance on the paths of righteousness. Offer your five daily Obligatory Prayers with such concentration and awe of mind as though you were seeing God in front of you. (*Kashti-e-Nuh, Ruhani Khaza'in*, vol. 19, p. 15)

Your Zaeem/Muntazim Tarbiyyat would also arrange an interactive local Tarbiyyat seminar during this week discussing relevant Tarbiyyat topics and would also contact you for a report.

Last but not the least may I request you to kindly pray that the Tarbiyyat week proves to be a success and is effective in reminding all of us the importance of Salat and recitation of The Holy Quran. Please feel free to contact me if you have any queries in this regard.
